### Memory Work:

- Very Important Passages:
  - **1 John 4:19 – Our life of love is a response of God’s love for us!**  
*We love because he first loved us.*
  - **Proverbs 3:5 – Put all of your trust in the LORD!**  
*Trust in the LORD with all your heart  
and lean not on your own understanding;*
  - **Hebrews 10:25 – Encouragement to get together with other Christians!**  
*Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the day approaching.”*
  - **Ephesians 6:1 – Give obedience to those God has placed over us!**  
*Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.*
  - REMEMBER – Extra passages in the lessons are extra credit

- Catechism Memory Work: Commandments 1-5 and “What Does This Mean?”

### Key Things to know from each lesson:

- Lesson 9 – Introduction to the 10 Commandments
  - In what two ways did God give his law?
  - When God gave the law at Mt. Sinai his law covered three general areas, what are those three groupings?
  - Give two reasons why God gave his law.
  - If you were to summarize God’s law with two phrases, what would those be?
  - If you were to summarize God’s law with ONE WORD, what would that be?
  - What is the believer’s attitude toward God’s Law?
- Lesson 10 – The First Commandment
  - The first commandment could be summarized with the phrase: “Love for \_\_\_\_\_”
  - Describe what it means to “fear” God.
  - What does it mean that we will love him above everything else?

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- What does it mean when we “trust” God?
  - Describe three ways we can sin against the first commandment.
  - How did Jesus keep the first commandment perfectly for us?
- Lesson 11 – The Second & Third Commandment
- The second commandment could be summarized with the phrase, “Love for \_\_\_\_\_”
  - What is God’s Name?
  - List at least three ways we can misuse the name of Jesus & briefly describe what each is or give an example of it.
  - List at least two ways we can properly use the name of Jesus and give example.
  - The third commandment could be summarized with the phrase, “Love for \_\_\_\_\_”
  - Give three reasons why God wants us to prioritize time with his word and worship?
- Lesson 12 – The Fourth & Fifth Commandments
- The fourth commandment could be summarized with the phrase, “Love for \_\_\_\_\_”
  - List the three areas of life where God has placed his representatives.
  - In your own words, describe how we are to interact with God’s Representatives.
  - What is the promise God gives as we follow the Fourth Commandment?
  - The fifth commandment could be summarized with the phrase, “Love for \_\_\_\_\_”
  - Who has the right to end a life (list 2)?
  - Why is a person’s life so valuable (list 2)?
  - Why do we want to take care of our bodies?
  - Put in your own words how this commandment encourages us to treat others.
