Memory Work:

- Very Important Passages:
 1. **2 Timothy 3:16 – All Scripture is inspired by God!**
All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God might be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
 2. **Galatians 3:27 – Baptism gives us a new set of clothes!**
All of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
 3. **Philippians 4:6 – Talk to God about everything in prayer!**
Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
 - REMEMBER – Extra passages in the lessons are extra credit
- Catechism Memory Work: Baptism: The Institution of Baptism & Baptism: The Blessings of Baptism (ALL parts of these)
- The Lord's Prayer (Just the words of the prayer, not what does this mean)

Key Things to know from each lesson:

 - The Birth, Life, Suffering and Death of Jesus (4BC – 29AD)
 - A History of the Early Christian Church (29-100 AD)

Season	Meaning	Color
Advent	“Coming” preparation for Christmas	Purple
Christmas	Birth of Christ	White
Epiphany	“Making known” Jesus revealing he is the Son of God	White Green (Sundays in Epiphany)
Lent	Focus on Jesus’ Suffering	Purple
Easter	Focus on Jesus’ Resurrection	White
Pentecost	Outpouring of the Holy Spirit and the Growth of the Christian Church	Red Green (Sundays in Pentecost)
