Memory Work:

- Very Important Passages:
 - 1. Ephesians 4:11-12 – God gives us individuals to help prepare us to serve!**
It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up
 - 2. 1 John 1:8-9 – Confess your sins! Enjoy God's full forgiveness!**
If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
 - 3. 1 Corinthians 11:28 – Be prepared before receiving the Lord's Supper**
A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup.
 - 4. Matthew 28:19-20 – Our purpose on earth? Share Jesus!**
Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
 - REMEMBER – Extra passages in the lessons are extra credit
- Catechism Memory Work: The Sacrament of Holy Communion:
 - The Institution of Holy Communion (What is the sacrament & Where is this written?)
 - The Blessings of Holy Communion (What blessings do we receive through this eating and drinking?)
