CONGREGATIONAL & VOTERS MEETING – UPDATE

After the congregational meeting, the Voters' helped to prioritize the project list, putting our online ministry needs as the top priority, followed by handicap ramps and repairs to the building. The Voters did approve seeking \$50,000 for the projects, celebrating the \$25,000 gift that has been given as a challenge for the rest of the congregation to give \$25,000 to match that. The voters meeting was recessed to reconvene on August 16 @ 7pm, asking the Council to bring clearer scope of work and bids for the projects.
