## **CONGREGATIONAL & VOTERS MEETING – UPDATE**

Here's a couple quick bullet points:

1. The Council postponed the Voters' Meeting scheduled for TODAY until August 30 to allow more time to secure adequate bids for the key projects.
  - a. Enhance our online broadcast capabilities
  - b. Install handicap ramps from parking area to sidewalks
  - c. Repair soffit and stucco to prevent further damage.
2. Voters approved seeking \$50,000 in special gifts from members to fund the top priorities and secondary projects as well. A single gift of \$25,000 was given to inspire the congregation to match it!

3. Communication was sent out this weekend electronically to add more detail and rationale to the project list.
4. A electronic questionnaire was also emailed to invite input and participation.


