

WE LISTEN TO THE WORD OF GOD

FIRST LESSON: *Ezekiel 34:11-16, 23-24 (NIV84)*

11 " 'For this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I myself will search for my sheep and look after them. 12 As a shepherd looks after his scattered flock when he is with them, so will I look after my sheep. I will rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on a day of clouds and darkness. 13 I will bring them out from the nations and gather them from the countries, and I will bring them into their own land. I will pasture them on the mountains of Israel, in the ravines and in all the settlements in the land. 14 I will tend them in a good pasture, and the mountain heights of Israel will be their grazing land. 

GOSPEL LESSON: *Matthew 27:27-31* (NIV84)
